ACCEPTANCE: Those applying by April 10 will be notified by April 20 whether you are accepted. (Rolling admissions after this date based on available space.)

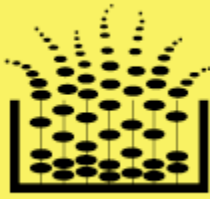
