Summary of Panel on i18n Skills and Challenges (Sat AM)

- Paul McKenney: leverage social change in the current generation, e.g. social networking is huge
- Maosong Sun: four challenges – English skills, ability to lead and organize international research teams, the cultural gap including the trust and friendship gap, training for leadership
- Martha Crosby: a very internationally diverse campus sets the stage
- Harold Javid: skills needed: we need the help of international awareness experts; notion of cs in a technological ecosystem; true interest in diversity; humor, respect, sense of adventure; details count, slowing down has great benefits
- Sue Moon: English and leadership skills (Korea will go to all English language instruction by 2010)
- Andrzej Proskurowski: inter-cultural interactions and collaborations are rewarding (and sometimes humorous)
- Yu-chee Tseng: they already have quite a bit of international interaction
